## CAMPING IS LIMITED TO 130 UNITS

- Pitch fees are £18.00 for Friday and Saturday nights only
- Arrivals welcome from 3pm but no later than 9pm without prior agreement
- Pitches will be pre-allocated and you MUST park as directed by Stewards or we will ask you to move
- Pitches will be 9 x 6 metres and you must park within your pitch
- Please indicate on the entry form if you would like to camp in a group and ensure you all put down the same name, we are not responsible if you don't!
- Please indicate on entry form if you would like your entry returned if camping is full
- Each unit/pitch must be equipped with its own fire extinguisher or bucket of water
- No barbeques or open fires are allowed at our venue
- Toilets and emptying points will be supplied, but there are no shower facilities
- The cricket pitch is out of bounds, anyone found on there will be asked to leave
- At the show speed limits are 5mph
- Please note that the camping area is right next to a small flying school. The flight path is directly above but the noise level is minimal as they are landing.
- **As camping is limited, those people offering to help will be given priority to a camping pitch on a first come first serve basis**

Our venue has vast amounts of fields but the owners are worried about the weather and having their fields churned up. A week before the show the venue has agreed to re-assess and we may be able to offer 70 extra camping pitches at the last minute. We will put an announcement on agilitynet if this is the case and you will be able to email or phone us to reserve a pitch and pay on arrival. All pitches will still be pre-allocated.

## DIRECTIONS

From M11: Leave the M11 at junction 8 and take the A120 signposted Braintree, stay on A120 passed Braintree for a further 5 miles. Then take B1024 (Left) signposted Earls Colne. Follow this road for approx 2.3 miles until you reach a pub called 'a bird in the hand'. Shortly after the pub there will be a turning on the left clearly marked 'Essex Golf and Country Club'. Our stewards will be here to direct you to the designated area.

From M25: Leave the M25 at junction 28 and take the A12 Eastbound. Leave the A12 at junction 25 and take the A120. Follow this road for 4 miles, and then take the B1024 signposted Earls Colne. Follow this road for approx 2.3 miles until you reach a pub called 'a bird in the hand'. Shortly after the pub there will be a turning on the left clearly marked 'Essex Golf and Country Club'. Our stewards will be here to direct you to the designated area.

From M25: Your sat nav's may direct you through Kelvedon or Coggeshall, please note these routes are not recommended with a caravan, both village High Streets are very narrow with lots of parked cars.

From A14: Leave the A14 at junction 55 and take the A12. Leave the A12 at junction 25 and take the A120. Follow this road for 4 miles, and then take the B1024 signposted Earls Colne. Follow this road for approx 2.3 miles until you reach a pub called 'a bird in the hand'. Shortly after the pub there will be a turning on the left clearly marked 'Essex Golf and Country Club'. Our stewards will be here to direct you to the designated area.

## **ELIGIBILITY & DEFINITION OF CLASSES**

### **In accordance with Kennel Club Rules, all dogs must have been officially measured before competing at a Kennel Club licensed agility show.**

Only first prizes and points (clear rounds) gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

**Class Structure.** A Class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded Class may be scheduled for one or more consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A Combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

**Progression.** Progression from each Grade will require one Agility win or three Jumping wins at that grade, except that progression from Grade 6 will require 4 wins at Grade 6, two of which must be agility classes. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

**Points Progression.** At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 5 by winning 75 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme, Regulation K3.c refers, except that there is no requirement for a minimum number of Agility points. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however, once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade.

## **STANDARD CLASSES**

**Grade 1 (Elementary)** - For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at a Kennel Club licensed Agility Show. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.

**Grade 2 (Starters)** - Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7, and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at a Kennel Club licensed Agility Show or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. N.B Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.

**Grade 3 (Graduate)** – Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility shows & dogs which are not eligible for Grades 4, 5, 6 or 7.

**Grade 4 (Novice)** – Open to dogs which have gained a 1st place in an Agility class or 3 first places in jumping classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at a Kennel Club licensed Agility shows and are not eligible for grades 3, 5, 6, or 7.

**Grade 5 (Intermediate)** – Open to dogs which have gained a 1st place in an Agility class or 3 first places in jumping classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility shows and are not eligible for grades 3, 4, 6 or 7.

**Grade 6 (Senior)** – Open to dogs which have gained a 1st place in an Agility Class or 3 first places in jumping classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

**Grade 7 (Advanced)** – Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 1st places at grade 6 at Kennel Club licensed Agility shows, 2 first places must be gained in agility (not jumping) classes.

## **Welfare of Dogs**

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel club Rules and Regulations.

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

## Show Rules and Regulations

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club regulations for classification and registration B. The registration number/authority to compete number will be required for each entry.
2. Entry fees: £2.80 per class. Camping £18 per pitch.
3. There is no prize money offered at this show.
4. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible to compete at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
6. Not for Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged 4 calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
7. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
8. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
9. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie not attached by a ring.
10. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
11. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
12. All offers of sponsorship or donations with the names of the sponsors.
13. Kennel Club Standard marking regulations apply.
14. The height of the hurdles will be:- Large dogs 65cms, Medium dogs 45cms and Small dogs 35cms.
15. The height limit for dogs are:
  - a. Large Dogs – for dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers
  - b. Medium Dogs – for dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers
  - c. Small Dogs – for dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers
16. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the show at which they are judging.
17. Withdrawal of dogs from Competition:

A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the show if it is:

  - a. A bitch which is in season
  - b. Suffering from any infectious disease or contagious disease
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent
  - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing
18. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition (6<sup>th</sup> April) shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry, for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show (17<sup>th</sup> April). The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor will be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
19. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultant with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
20. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the Club/Society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope submitted within 1 month of the show date.
21. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
22. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
23. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease – No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42.
24. Animals in Event

No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dog registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
25. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
26. Pay on the day classes will be held if time permits.
27. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show, if space allows. This ring will be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.
28. Welfare of Dogs

An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and wealth at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
29. All dogs are entered at this Show at the owners risk and whilst the committee will take every reasonable care, it shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury, howsoever caused to dogs, people or property at the Show.
30. Respect the venue and pick up after your dog(s) and dispose of all rubbish in bins provided. Anyone knowingly not doing so will be asked to leave the venue and will forfeit any remaining class entries.
31. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their classes and running order.
32. Handlers working more than one dog in a class must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequences in which they are drawn. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
33. Any person under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
34. Parents will be held responsible for the actions of their children. Please ensure your children do not cause any damage or interfere with equipment or the property of the club or others.
35. The cricket pitch is out of bounds, anyone found on there will be asked to leave.
36. Organisers reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the show/showground for actions deemed detrimental to the show.

## Colchester Dog Agility Open KC Show – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2010

This form must be used by one person only (or partnership). Writing MUST BE IN INK OR INDELIBLE PENCIL. Use one line only for each dog.

The name of the dog and all the details as recorded with the Kennel Club must be given on this entry form. If an error is made the dog may be disqualified by the Committee of the Kennel Club. All dogs must be REGISTERED at the Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by the Kennel Club. Dogs under 18 months of age on the first day of the Show cannot be entered for competition.
