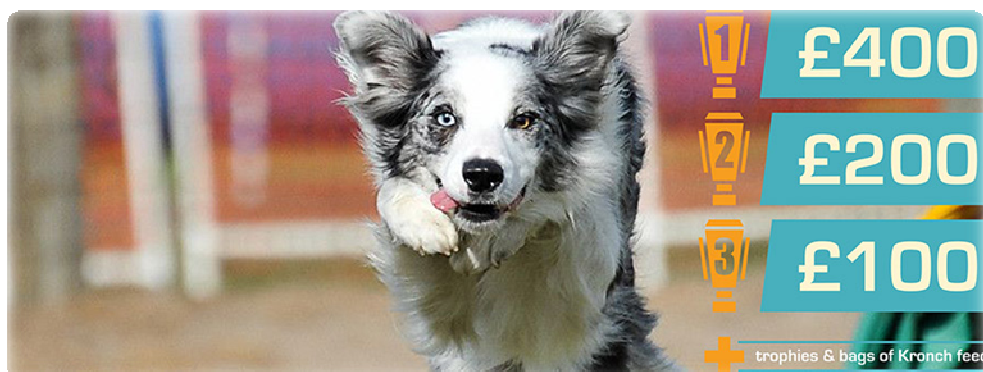

The Kronch British Agility Championships is a competition designed for grades 6 and 7. A single handler is allowed to enter as many grade 6 or 7 dogs as they wish in as many height categories as they wish.

Grade 6 (Senior)

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 3 first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an Agility (not Jumping) Class, and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7 (Advanced)

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

Entries will be on a first come first serve basis and entries will be capped at

Large	140 Entries
Medium	60 Entries
Small	60 Entries

Structure

Each competitor will be guaranteed to run 4 qualification rounds: 2 x agility rounds and 2 x jumping rounds. These courses will be the qualification rounds for the Sunday evening final. Over the 4 rounds each dog and handler combination will score points from their placing's. The top 20 dogs in each height category after the 4 rounds will go forward into the Sunday evening Grand Championship Finals, where the winners will be crowned "Kronch British Agility Champion".

Scoring of the qualification rounds

In the qualification rounds faults will be turned into time, e.g. 5 Faults = 5 seconds, and added to the time taken to complete the round.

As a dog and handler partnership you will be able to gain points for each of the rounds if you place within the top 25 of Small and Medium Size Categories or the top 30 of Large dog Categories. Dogs placing outside the top 25 in small and medium or the top 30 in the large will score 1 point unless eliminated, in which case NO points will be awarded.

Scoring of the Finals

The Finals will be scored as per normal, i.e. dogs with the least faults in the fastest time will win.

General Rules and Regulations

The Kronch British Agility Championships will run under the current British Kennel Club ruling.

Please note that this event is not an official KC event, and that any wins and/or places will not count towards any progression with in the KC progression system.

General Rules

- Open to all Grade 6 and 7 dogs
- Separate competition for each height categories
- Handlers must run in strict running orders in all rounds, failure to do so will result in elimination.
- A maximum of 1 minute is given if a handler fails to appear at ring side for their running order, failing to appear within that time, will result in elimination.
- Where a handler is running 2 dogs drawn with in two dogs of each other the handler will be given a maximum of 2 minute break between dogs.
- If there is a tie on points when scoring for the overall final positions the agility rounds will take priority. (both agility scores will be added together and the handler with the least time and faults when added together will be the winner)
- A dog can still progress to the finals with one or more eliminations, as long as they score enough points to make the final cut.
- Whistle start maybe used.
- All standard KC equipment may be used.
- A dog will run at its Kennel Club height and may not change height even if under an appeal process with the Kennel Club or other Organisation.
- In the event of a tie of time and faults in an individual qualifying round, both dogs and handlers will be awarded equal points in the individual rounds (see example at www.britishagilitychampionships.com).
- Organisers/Judge's decisions are final.
