RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club Ltd in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B, or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The registration number/ authority to compete (ATC) number will be required for each entry.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC) number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. Entry fees: £3.00 per dog per class, £6.00 per pairs entry. Camping fees: £25.00 per space for 3 nights (Thurs, Fri, Sat)
4. No Prize Money is on offer.
5. All entries to be made via Longhedge Show Processing.
6. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries.
7. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition to compete at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
8. Not for competition, entries will be accepted for dogs aged four months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
9. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
10. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
11. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting leather or webbing collar is permitted providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
12. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
13. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
14. Thank you to our sponsors – Just So Jump and Twist Pairs Jewlnick leather
15. Kennel Club Standard marking Regulations apply for all standard classes.
16. The heights of the jump obstacles will be: Large 65cm, Medium 45cm, Small, 35cm (Veteran/Any size excepted) unless otherwise stated.
17. The Height limit for dogs:
 - a. Large Dogs – For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
 - b. Medium Dogs - For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.
 - c. Small Dogs – For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.
18. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog, which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging. Dogs will be disqualified if proved to have been handled by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
19. Withdrawal of dogs from Competition - A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from an Agility Show if it is:
 - d. A bitch, which is in season.
 - e. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - f. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - g. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - h. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
20. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition, i.e. 06/07/2014, shall be counted when entering any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show (18/07/2014). The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the Corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor will be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
21. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
22. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees less reasonably incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope submitted within 1 month of the show date.
23. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to the dog in the ring.
24. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
25. Separate entry forms must be completed by each competitor and must be signed by the competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
26. Passes are not required to gain entry to the show/showground.
27. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease - No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during 21 days prior to the competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and /or dealt with under the Kennel Club Rule A42.
28. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club.
29. Animals in Event

No other animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming that the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under control at all times.
30. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
31. A pay on the day class will be held if time and weather permits.
32. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show if time and space allows. This ring to be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.
33. Welfare of Dogs

An exhibitor/competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog[s] are met, and should knowingly put their dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
34. All dogs entered at this show are at the owner's risk. Whilst every care will be taken, the Committee and Organisers will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury, however caused to persons, dogs or property at the show.
35. Overpaid entries will NOT be refunded.
36. Strictly NO refunds after the closing date.
37. Camping: Spaces will be allocated and each pitch will be a minimum of 9m x 10m. Units must be placed as per the map that will be provided.
38. Maximum of 2 dogs off-lead per adult in the exercise area.
39. Anyone found not picking up after their dogs will be asked to leave the venue immediately.
40. No selling of goods on the show venue without prior permission.
41. A charge of £10.00 will be made for any returned / unpaid cheques.

ELIGIBILITY OF CLASSES

In the following definitions of classes First Prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licensed Championship Agility, Premier Agility, Open Agility or Limited Agility Shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events excepted). Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Progression. Progression from each Grade will require one Agility win or three Jumping wins in standard classes at that grade, except that progression from Grade 5 will require 3 wins at Grade 5, one of which must be an agility class. Progression from Grade 6 will require 4 wins at Grade 6, two of which must be agility classes. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

Points Progression. At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme (Regulation K3.c refers), except that there is no requirement for a minimum number of agility points. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade. Progression on points must be done prior to the closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.

Standard Classes

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

Grade 1 (Elementary)

For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.

Grade 2 (Starters)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.

Grade 3 (Graduate)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4 (Novice)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 5 (Intermediate)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6 (Senior)

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 3 first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an Agility (not Jumping) Class, and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7 (Advanced)

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

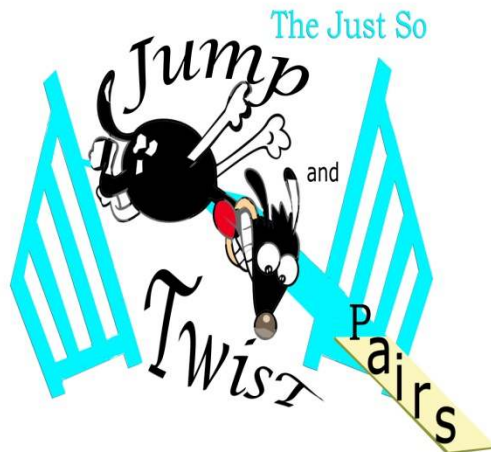
SPECIAL CLASSES

Please note that in all special classes, standard Kennel Club marking will apply.

For sponsored classes or qualifiers, please read the relevant rules as they may differ from those below.

Veterans: Open to all dogs 7 years or over on the day of the show and not entered in any other classes over the week (other Veteran and Any Size classes. Jumps will be set at 350mm for Large dogs and 228mm for Small and Medium dogs. These classes will not include weaves or a tyre and the course time will be 60 seconds. All dogs will compete against each other over the same course at the dog's applicable jump height with one set of awards.

Any Size: Open to all dogs not entered in any other classes over the weekend (other Any Size and Veteran classes plus Brace excepted). Jumps will be set at 350mm for Large dogs and 228mm for Small and Medium dogs. These classes will not include weaves or a tyre. The course time will be 60 seconds. All heights of dogs will compete against each other over the same course at the dog's applicable jump height with one set of awards.



Prizes RULES
THE JUST SO JUMP AND TWIST PAIRS

- This class is open to pairs of the same height, small, medium and large.
- It is open to Grades 1-7
- It is a combined class with one set of awards
- One dog will complete an agility course and the other dog a jumping course
- The judge will decide which course will be run first
- The agility course shall consist of twelve obstacles and must include three contacts (they do not have to be three different pieces of contact equipment) and twelve weaves.
- The jumping course shall consist of twelve obstacles one of which must be twelve weaves.
- There will be a changeover box and a baton exchange in the box
- A faulty baton change will incur 100 faults
- The first three pairs from each heat will qualify for the final which will be at Tag Summer Show.
- Once a pair has qualified they may enter other heats for competition but the place in the final will be awarded to the next highest placed pair who has not qualified.
- The sponsors will provide first place trophies and rosettes to 5th place.

From the A14 Exit Junction 13 take A605 towards Peterborough stay on this road (approx 10 miles) until you reach the Warmington roundabout (jet garage just before roundabout) turn left towards Tansor Nassington ** at the T junc turn right Fotheringhay / Nassington over small hump back bridge (narrow) through Fotheringhay village towards Woodnewton. Approx 1 mile small junction turn left (will be marked agility show) venue half mile on right on the right at top of hill.

From the A1 Exit A1 A605 head towards Northampton/ Kettering stay on this road approx 6 miles until you get to the WARMINGTON Roundabout turn right towards Tansor Nassington ** follow directions.
