# The 'Laser' Knockout Pairs Rules

The 'Laser' knockout pairs is a fun competition, sponsored by Blair and Jenny Willis in memory of Laser (Fels Magic Laser), who really loved competing in the knockout pairs competitions.

- 1) The class will be open only to large dogs which are eligible to compete at Large Grades 1,2,3,4,5,6 and 7.
- 2) There will be eight qualifying heats. The top four pairs from each heat will qualify for the Final, which will take place at TAG summer show in 2012. Once a pair has qualified for the final, they may not run in further heats for the final which they have qualified for.
- 3) Handlers may enter more than one pair. Dogs may only compete in one pair in any heat. If a handler has entered more than one pair and is drawn to run against themselves, they may nominate another handler to run one of the dogs, that handler must then continue to run the dog for the rest of the heat and if they qualify for the final, they must run the dog in the final. Alternatively the handler can nominate which pair should continue in the heat.
- 4) The pairs will compete against each other over two similar courses. There will be a judge for each course. There will be a baton change between the first and second handler which must take place behind a line, failure to do so will incur 100 faults. Time and faults will be added together and the winning pair will be the one with the lowest time. The judges' decision will be final.
- 5) The course will consist of 10 obstacles ,made up of jumps, tunnels and weaves (6 poles) only. Normal marking will apply. If a dog is eliminated, it will incur 100 faults. Should both pairs be eliminated, the pair which was eliminated first will lose.
- 6) The winning pairs from each round will go through to the next round until there is only one pair remaining.
- 7) Pairs will be issued with a running order which must be strictly adhered to. Pairs failing to run when due will be knocked out and the other pair will go through to the next round.
- 8) Only handlers and dogs originally entered may compete at the final (except in the case of rule 3). Any changes are at the organisers' discretion.

The winners and runners up for each heat will receive a trophy and rosettes will be presented to the last 8 pairs.

## ANY SIZE Classes

Dogs may only enter these classes if they are not entered in any other classes at the show. (veteran classes included)

Jump heights will be set at Small & Micro.

These classes will not have any weaves.

## VETERAN Classes

**For Border Collies 9yrs & over. All other breeds 7yrs & over.**

Dogs may only enter these classes if they are not entered in any other classes at the show. (any size included)

Jump heights will be set at Small & Micro.

These classes may contain 6 weaves.

These classes will be nice flowing course's

## Junior Classes

**Open to all aged 16yrs and under.**

Open to all Grades & All Heights.

Awards will be by Grade. ie All Grade one Large , Med & Small compete for one set of awards.

Each class will start with Large Dogs, then all medium & finally all small dogs.

Course designed to be flowing to encourage more junior handlers to be confident and enjoy the sport.

## *Dog Vegas/Jewlnick Diamond Pairs Combined 1-7 agility...All Heights*

- 1.** Each Pair to consist of 2 dogs of the same height, either 2 Small, 2 Medium or 2 Large. No other combination.
- 2.** The course should include all 3 contacts (weather permitting) & 6 weave. With a minimum of 14 obstacles.
- 3.** This is a relay with a baton.
- 4.** Any dog that results in elimination would incur 100 faults.
- 5.** The top 3 pairs from each heat would be invited to the Dog Vegas / Jewlnick Diamond Pairs Final that would be held at the 12<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> October Dog Vegas Show in 2012.

*Sponsor trophies to 1<sup>st</sup> place, sponsor rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> place.*

**Trophies & Rosettes-Dependent on entries in each Grade/Class.  
Clear Round Rosettes for unplaced dogs in all Grades/ Classes.**

**For each dog entered in each " Vegas" class the sum of £1.00 will go into the Class pot, which will be given out in the Vegas classes.**

**Example... 120 DOGS entered in class 72 large graded 1 -3 agility Would result in £120 being awarded out between the top 10% of each grade**

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES**

In the following definitions of classes First Prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licensed Open Agility Shows (i.e. Limited Agility Shows, special classes and invitation events excepted). Only a first place with a clear round **within course time** will count towards grade progression.

Agility classes to include contact points and Jumping classes where there are no contact obstacles. With this proviso classes are defined as follows:-

**Class Structure.** A Class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded Class may be scheduled for one or more consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A Combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

**Progression.** Progression from each Grade will require one Agility win or three Jumping wins at that grade, except that progression from Grade 6 will require 4 wins at Grade 6, two of which must be agility classes. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

**Points Progression.** At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 5 by winning 75 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme (Regulation K3.c refers), except that there is no requirement for a minimum number of agility points. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade.

### **STANDARD CLASSES**

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

### Grade 1 (Elementary)

For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. N.B. Owners handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class

### Grade 2 (Starters)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. N.B. Owners handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class

### Grade 3 (Graduate)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7

### Grade 4 (Novice)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7

### Grade 5 (Intermediate)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

### Grade 6 (Senior)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7

### Grade 7 (Advanced)

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes

### KC Rules and Regulations

1. Dogs entered at KC licensed Agility shows must be registered at The Kennel Club in accordance with KC regulations for classification and registration B, or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The registration number/Authority to compete (ATC) number will be required for each entry.
2. Entry - £2.85 per dog per class, "Vegas" classes are £3.85 per dog per class. Pairs entry £5.70. Camping fees are: £25 per unit thus to Sat, and Sun to Wed £7 per night.
3. Prize money will be awarded in the "Vegas" classes. Each £1 per entry in these classes will be distributed amongst the 10% in each "Vegas" class.
4. All entries to be made via the Show processor "Longhedge Show Processing"
5. The committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
6. Dog under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible to compete at KC licensed Agility Shows.
7. Not for competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged 4 calendar months & over. Dogs must be KC registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
8. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
9. No person shall carry out punitive, corrective or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
10. Dogs must not wear any type of slip; half-slip collars or leads when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather, or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
11. Should a judge be unable to fulfill the appointment to judge the committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
12. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges
13. Sponsors: Active Pet Feeds Rosettes to 10% in sponsored classes. Jenny Willis trophies to 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place & rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>. Jewnick Trophies to 1<sup>st</sup> place & rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> place. Kennel Club standard-marking regulations shall apply
14. Any size & Veteran jump heights will be 35cm (14") and 22cm (9")
15. The Height limit for dogs. A) Large Dog Classes for dogs measuring over 430mm at the withers. B) Medium Dog Classes for dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers. C) Small dog classes for dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers.
16. Judges at an Agility show may not enter for competition a dog, which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the show at which they are judging. Dogs will be disqualified if proved to have been handled by the scheduled judges spouse or immediate family or resident at the same address at the judge.
17. Withdrawal of dogs from competition: A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the show if it is:-
  - a. A bitch in season.
  - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
18. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the START of the competition i.e. (4<sup>th</sup> June 2012) & (11<sup>th</sup> June 2012) shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show processor at least 14 days (15<sup>th</sup> June 2012) & (22<sup>nd</sup> June 2012) before the date of the show. The dog should then be moved into the corresponding number of class(es) as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
19. Should circumstances so dictate, DVC, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
20. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the society (DVC) will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped address envelope submitted within 1 month of the show date.
21. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to the dog in the ring.
22. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted
23. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his authorized agent in accordance with provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees.
24. Free passes are not applicable at this show.
25. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease - No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under KC rule A42
26. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the KC.
27. Animals in Event. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
28. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC) number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an authority to compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
29. A pay on the day class may run if time and weather permits

30. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show, if space allows. This ring must be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.
31. **Welfare of Dogs.** An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and regulations.
32. Dogs entered are at the owners risk and whilst every care will be taken by DVC Committee, officials & sponsors will accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury howsoever caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.
33. RTD cheques will incur an extra £10 charge..
34. If a refund is requested by a competitor :- a) Any entries that have been received and processed, then cancelled before the closing date of the show will be refunded with a deduction of the processing costs per entry plus £1.74p to cover the cost of postage and bank charges for cashing and issuing the refund cheque. B) After the closing date, no refunds will be given.
35. No unclaimed rosettes will be posted, unless the competitor sends a SAE.
36. Competitors must follow the instructions of the Stewards with respect to parking, camping and conduct within the show boundaries.
37. Whilst every care will be taken, DVC will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, dogs or property whilst at the show.
38. All caravans/camping units must carry suitable fire extinguishers and facilities for fire fighting.
39. Please clear up after your dogs. Anyone knowingly not doing so will be asked to leave the showground forfeiting any remaining entries.
40. Adults who accompany children are responsible for their children's behavior, actions and safety
41. **Max 3 DOGS PER PERSON TO BE TAKEN ONTO THE EXERCISE AREA AT A TIME**
42. **Competitors who allow their dog/dogs to make excessive noise during unsociable hours will be requested by the show manager to keep them quiet. Failure to do so would result in the competitor being required to leave the venue within 1 hour of the decision of the show manager.**

### **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS**

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts traveling to and whilst at KC licensed events.

- When traveling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether traveling to the show is a good idea at all.
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

**WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries. Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry.
