## **ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES**

In the following definitions of classes, First Prizes or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club Ltd licensed Championship Agility, Premier Agility, Open Agility or Limited Agility Shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events excepted). Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Agility classes to include contact obstacles and Jumping classes where there are no contact obstacles. With this proviso, classes are defined as follows:-

**Class Structure.** A class may be either held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded Class may be scheduled for one or more consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. A Combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results.

**Progression.** Progression from each Grade will require one Agility win or three Jumping wins in standard classes at that grade, except that progression from Grade 5 will require 3 wins at Grade 5, one of which must be an agility class. Progression from Grade 6 will require 4 wins at Grade 6, two of which must be agility classes. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade.

**Points Progression.** At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant points scheme, (Regulation K3.c refers), except that there is no requirement for a minimum number of agility points. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression. However, once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade. Progression on points must be done prior to the closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.

## **STANDARD CLASSES**

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club Ltd licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

### **Grade 1 (Elementary)**

For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club Ltd licensed Agility Shows or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. *N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 (Elementary), are not eligible for this class.*

### **Grade 2 (Starters)**

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club Ltd licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. *N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters), are not eligible for this class.*

### **Grade 3 (Graduate)**

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club Ltd licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

### **Grade 4 (Novice)**

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club Ltd licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

### **Grade 5 (Intermediate)**

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

### **Grade 6 (Senior)**

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 3 first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club Ltd licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an Agility (not Jumping Class) and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

### **Grade 7 (Advanced)**

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Ltd licensed Agility Shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

## SPECIAL CLASSES

Please note that in all special classes, standard Kennel Club Ltd marking will apply.

**Any Size Agility Class 24 and Any Size Jumping Classes 25 and 46** - These classes are intended for all sizes of dogs that are not entered in any other classes at this show and are particularly suitable for inexperienced dogs or handlers, and those dogs that are unable to compete at their full height. These classes will have no weaves or tyre. Class 22 will have no seesaw or long jump, the A frame will have a maximum height of 1.2M. at the apex. Jumps will be set at 35cm for large dogs and 25cms for small & medium dogs. The courses will be very simple and flowing. NB Trophies and place rosettes will not be awarded for these classes but all clear rounds within the course time will receive a clear round rosette and a treat for the dog.

### Competition Rules

The "Dog Vegas Qualifier" is a competition for Large dogs, eligible for Grade 6

There will be approximately ten **qualifying heats**. The top 5 dogs from each heat (top 3 if the heat is split into 2 parts), will qualify for the "**Dog Vegas**" **Grand Final** comprising approximately 50 dogs at the July Dog Vegas show in 2015.

1. This class must be judged under the appropriate Kennel Club Ltd Rules in force at the time of the competition
2. If the entry for a heat exceeds the KC limit for a judge in a day then the class will be equally and randomly split and another judge appointed for the second part.
3. All competitors entering the class will be deemed to have agreed to abide by the rules of the Kennel Club and the specific regulations governing this class.
4. Handlers may enter more than one dog in the competition and may qualify more than one dog for the final event.
5. Once a dog has qualified for the final it may enter further heats, as long as it is still eligible for Grade 6.
6. Handlers who have already qualified their dog for the final must report this fact to the appropriate Show Secretary before running in the class. If the already qualified dog then qualifies again, the place will be awarded to the highest placed unqualified dog.
7. The first five dogs from the heat will be invited to compete in the final. The next five dogs will be held as reserves.
8. If the class is split the top three dogs from each part will be invited to compete in the final. The next top three in each part will be held as reserves.
9. In the event of a dog being unable to compete in the final due to unavailability, illness or injury the reserves from that heat will be called up in numerical order.
10. In the event of a handler being unable to compete in a final due to illness or injury a substitute handler for the qualifying dog will be allowed to run the dog.

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Ltd licensed agility shows must be registered at the Kennel Club Ltd in accordance with the Kennel Club Ltd regulations for classification and registration B or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. . The registration number/Authority to Compete number will be required for each entry.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Ltd Authority to Compete (ATC) number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Ltd Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. Entry fees:- £2.80 per dog per class. Helping Bromsgrove DTC members - Free. Camping fees are £19 for the weekend (available Friday and Saturday nights).
4. No monetary prizes are on offer.
5. Entries must be made on the official form or a photocopy thereof.
6. The Committee of Bromsgrove DTC reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
7. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition at Kennel Club Ltd licensed Agility Shows.
8. Not for competition (NFC) entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months or over. Dogs must be Kennel Club Ltd registered with their details recorded on the entry form. There will be no entry fee for these dogs.
9. No bitch in season is allowed to compete
10. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
11. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar, i.e. not attached by a ring.
12. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
13. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
14. **Sponsors:**, First Contact, jlj Healthcare , Chris Jones Leisure, Equestrian and Country Leisure Ltd, Clent Hill Vets, Wafcol,
15. Kennel Club Ltd standard marking regulations apply for all standard classes..
16. Hurdles for Any Size classes will be set at 35cm for large dogs and 25cms for small & medium dogs.
17. The height limit for dogs:
  - a. Large Dogs – for dogs measuring over 430 mm (1ft 5 ins) at the withers
  - b. Medium dogs – for dogs measuring over 350 mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430 mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers
  - c. Small dogs – for dogs measuring 350 mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.
18. Judges at an agility show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging. Dogs may be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
19. Withdrawal of dogs from the competition - A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from an Agility Show if it is:
  - a. a bitch in season
  - b. suffering from any infectious or contagious diseases
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent
  - d. of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal
  - e. likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing
20. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition (i.e.26th August 2014) shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor will be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
21. Should circumstances so dictate the society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
22. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances Bromsgrove Dog Training Club will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provisions to do so, competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they had entered the show but in any event the Club will refund fees within 3 months of the show date on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.
23. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
24. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any result and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
25. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
26. No Passes are required to gain entry to the showground.
27. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease – No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Ltd Rule A42.
28. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. **Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club Ltd.**
29. Animals in Event - No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
30. A Pay on the Day class will be held if time permits.
31. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show, if space allows. This ring must be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.
32. Welfare of Dogs  
An exhibitor/competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club Ltd licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog[s] are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Ltd Rules and Regulations.
33. Handlers working more than one dog in a class must ensure that the dogs compete in the sequence in which they are drawn. Failure to do so will result in elimination.
34. Dogs will not be received for competition after the class/grade has been declared closed.
35. All dogs are entered at their owner's risk. Whilst every care will be taken, Bromsgrove DTC will not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to persons, dogs or property.

36. No refunds will be given in the event of incorrect monies being submitted. It is the competitor's responsibility to check the paperwork before submission.
37. Competitors must follow the instructions of the Stewards with respect to parking, camping and conduct within the show boundaries and any person directing abuse at the Stewards will be removed from the showground.
38. Children brought to the show are the responsibility of the adult/s accompanying them. Any behavioural misconduct will result in you leaving the show and forfeiting any further entry and camping monies paid.
39. Campers must remain within a marked space and MUST NOT obstruct the roadways. All units must be equipped with own fire extinguishers and/or bucket of water at the tow bar.
40. All competitors who enter special classes agree to the rules for such classes as defined in the schedule by Bromsgrove DTC.
41. **DOGS ARE NOT TO BE LEFT LOOSE IN 'GARDEN' AREAS OR TETHERED TO VEHICLES WITHOUT BEING ATTENDED.**
42. **NO MORE THAN 2 DOGS OFF LEAD PER PERSON IN THE EXERCISE AREA.**
43. No overnight parking permitted unless a camping space has been booked and paid for and you are within a marked space. Any persons with vehicles parked overnight, not in accordance with this rule, will be asked to leave the showground.

## **General Information**

**Use of the PA at this show will be limited.** It will not be used before 9 am on either day nor during the time of the Church service on Sunday morning. Presentations will be done at the secretary's tent over a local tannoy. Competitors who bring their own walkie-talkies will be able to listen in on the traffic between the secretary's tent and the rings. All competitors are reminded that in accordance with KC regulations H(1) 3.117 (10) (f) it is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. **(See Rule 28)**

**Camping is limited to 120 units.** Please tick on the entry form whether you would like your entry returned if camping is full. No arrivals will be accepted before 1pm on Friday 19th September unless by prior arrangement. Camping will not be allocated, however we would request that you keep your unit within the area marked out. Should you arrive at the venue after 9pm, we would be grateful if you could please find a suitable spot to park up for the evening so that you do not disturb other campers. Thank you for your co-operation.

A limited number of electrical hook-ups are available on the site at £6 for the weekend. Please come and pay at the Secretary's tent.

## **Directions to the venue**

**From M5 junction 7** – leave motorway following signs for Worcester City Centre. At first roundabout turn left, taking the A4440 Worcester West. Go straight over the next 2 roundabouts. At the third roundabout take the third exit, taking the road back in towards Worcester (St. Johns). At the next roundabout take the third exit 'Bromwich Road' (Jet garage on your left) Continue to traffic lights, go straight over and get into left hand lane of this one-way system, bear left at McDonalds, signed to Tenbury Wells (Hylton Road - A443). Continue on the A443 through Hallow village, past Grimley Raceway, then after approx 3/4 mile look out for signs to Top Barn farm on your right. \*Turn in, follow tarmac road for approx 250 yds, bear left at the bottom of the slope, follow track which will then bear right up a hill into the venue.

**From M5 junction 6** – From the West, leave M5 at J6. Take middle lane at traffic lights on the exit slip road signed A449. After 4 miles at first roundabout, turn right signed for Kidderminster. After approx 2 miles take left hand slip road to Ombersley, also signed (A4133). At first roundabout turn left then again turn left in Holt at mini roundabout, (follow signs for Worcester) at end of this short cut, turn left to pick up the A443. After approx 1 mile look out for windsurfing lake on your left, the entrance is approximately 100 yds from this on your left. Proceed as above from \*.
